Key Selection Criteria:

Eligible postgraduate courses must:

- be delivered by a university or other accredited higher education provider
- lead to an award qualification at a postgraduate certificate or postgraduate diploma level
- include clinical nursing or midwifery practice related to the selected area of study.

Supported areas of practice may include (but are not limited to):

- Palliative care (Cherie Waight Nursing Scholarship)
- Aged care, renal dialysis, chronic disease, diabetes, and oncology
- Other postgraduate nursing and midwifery courses.
