Prof. Jacques P. Brown is a rheumatologist and Canadian authority in metabolic bone diseases. He is a clinical professor at the Faculty of Medicine, Université Laval and a clinical researcher at the CHU de Québec Research Centre – Université Laval.

He is a Director for the "Canadian Multicentre Osteoporosis Study" and the Principal Investigator of the "Recognizing Osteoporosis and its Consequences in Quebec" Programme. Dr. Brown twice received the John B Johnson Award from The Paget Foundation for his outstanding contribution to Paget's disease of bone research and was awarded the Lindy Fraser Memorial Award from Osteoporosis Canada for his leadership and dedication to the "2002 Clinical practice guidelines for the diagnosis and management of osteoporosis in Canada". In 2009, he was decorated as a Knight of the Ordre national du Québec, the highest distinction awarded by the Quebec government.
