Digital imaging technology is a particularly advantageous for young patients due to its fast image acquisition and low dose capabilities. Our sites follow stringent paediatric protocols, following guidance from the Royal Children's Hospital. Paediatric radiologists are onsite for general x-ray reporting, and for performing and guiding a broad range of paediatric examinations across modalities.

General Practitioners and Specialist have free access to Breast MRI's for patients who have or may have breast implants manufactured by French Company, Poly Implant Prostheses (PIP). Sunshine Hospital has a full Medicare rebate for its MRI and will Bulk Bill all eligible implant patients (please note the referral must identify the patient has or where clinical advice states might have PIP implants). The government has implemented this initiative to ensure the structure of these PIP implants can be assessed. This initiative is available until March 2013.
