CT – Paranasal Sinus Diagnosis



CT is a useful imaging modality in the diagnosis of sinus passage obstruction or inflammation that is unresponsive to first line treatment. A CT scan can clearly depict all of the paranasal sinuses, surrounding structures and any infection/inflammation that may be present. Some of these may include total blockage in one or more sinuses; air/fluid levels in one or more sinuses and thickening of the mucosa consistent with inflammation or infection.

Western Health Medical Imaging can perform this test in approximately 10 minutes at all sites. Radiation exposure it is approximately equal to one month of normal background radiation. There are dedicated CT sinus examination times at all WHMI sites readily available for your patients and no booking time is required for these appointments. Walk-ins welcome.

General Practitioner Education Evening Cardiac Imaging and Assessment

The evening was a major success with an intimate group of attendees complimenting both the presentation of the machine's journey and the knowledge shared by ourstaff.

The SPECT/CT is now operational at our Sunshine Campus with plans already underway for a new SPECT/CT for Footscray in the new year. These advances in technology put Western Health Medical Imaging at the forefront of diagnostic imaging in Victoria.

Combined SPECT/CT devices provide both the functional information from SPECT and the anatomic information from CT in a single examination. By precisely localizing areas of abnormal tracer uptake, SPECT/CT improves sensitivity and specificity.
