



Sunbury Day Hospital

Western Health is the pre-eminent provider of health services in the western metropolitan region of Melbourne. Fast becoming known as a vibrant progressive organisation focused on achieving excellence in patient care, Western Health serves one of the most multicultural regions of Melbourne and offers an extensive range of health services to a population of approximately 650,000 people.

Western Health was allocated \$15 million for the first stage development of the Sunbury Day Hospital.

A further \$6.4 million was allocated for Stage 2 of the facility in the 2009/10 Budget to provide a two operating theatre day surgery facility. This funding will enable this site to develop into an important facility for Western Health providing additional dedicated day surgery capacity - uninterrupted by emergency workload.

The facility will assist Western Health to deliver safe and effective patient care to the Sunbury community. Between the years 2006 to 2016 the population of Sunbury is projected to increase by more than 10%.

Sunbury Day Hospital Fast Facts

- The Sunbury Day Hospital will increase the range of services available to Sunbury and surrounds,
- Services to be provided include at the site will include:
 - Low complexity same day surgical procedures
 - Same day medical procedures including renal dialysis and day chemotherapy
 - A range of specialist clinics to meet the needs of the local community.
- Co-location of the Sunbury Day Hospital with the Sunbury Community Health Centre will establish a Sunbury Healthcare precinct.
- Detailed planning for the building on the site of the Ardcloney House is nearing completion and development of the site will commence in late 2009.
