INTRODUCTION TO DEMENTIA AND SERVICES

A good place to start

Suitable for: Family and friends of a person who may have a diagnosis of dementia and for the person who has the diagnosis.

Overview: This session will provide an introduction to dementia, causes, symptoms and typical changes that may occur. Also discussed are services available to support the person and the family, including further information sessions.

Session Date and Time:

Thursday 8 May from 1.30-3.30pm

EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION

Suitable for: Family and friends of a person diagnosed with dementia who already have a basic understanding of dementia and need assistance with effective communication.

Overview: The focus of the session is on how dementia changes communication and possible alternate communication strategies which may be helpful. We also discuss dealing with over-reactions of a person with dementia and how to support the person who is distressed.

Session Date and Time:

Thursday 5 June from 1.30-4pm

COPING WITH CHANGES IN BEHAVIOUR

Suitable for: Family carers who need support coping with changed behaviours.

Overview: This session deals with some of the changes in behaviour caused by dementia as well as the possible triggers to these behaviours. We teach participants a problem-solving approach which helps carers to understand and better manage these changes.

Session Date and Time:

Thursday 3 July from 1.30-4pm

CONSIDERING RESIDENTIAL CARE

Suitable for: Family carers at the point of considering residential care for a family member with dementia

Overview: In this program, we discuss the difficult decision of when to decide that residential care is needed, including the barriers to making this decision, and the emotional issues for families regarding placement. Information is also provided about the residential care system, including the different types of care available, and where to get information, and what services to contact. Discussion of the family's new role and how they can continue to care is included in this program.


