Aim of the program

To facilitate learning and develop practical experience in preparation for registration as a pharmacist.

Structure of the program

Practical training: An intensive clinical and manufacturing training week is conducted at the beginning of the year's rotations.

Throughout the year, Western Health's highly experienced pharmacists offer invaluable training to help interns achieve competency and learning objectives as described in our in-house competency framework.

Rotations

A series of 4 weekly rotations between Footscray and Sunshine hospitals include:

Ward rotations
 General Medical wards
 General Surgical wards
 Specialty wards (Cardiology, Respiratory,
 Infectious Disease, Neurology).

From the second half of the year, interns are rostered with a higher caseload and learn to effectively manage the ward.

Education and Exam Preparation

Weekly tutorials: a 1.5hr tutorial is conducted by three preceptors on set topics. Clinical, OTC and APCAT topics are covered.

Tutorials will also be provided from Pharmacists working in specialty areas as well as other departments including the Asthma clinic.

Mock oral exams are formally conducted in preparation for the oral exam.
