Positions

Aim of the program

To facilitate learning and develop practical experience in preparation for registration as a pharmacist.

Structure of the program

Practical training: An intensive clinical and manufacturing training week is conducted twice a year.

Throughout the year, Western Health's highly experienced pharmacists offer invaluable training to help interns achieve competency and learning objectives as described in our in-house competency framework.

Rotations are spread between Footscray and Sunshine hospitals to include the below as well as multi-disciplinary pain, antimicrobial rounds and IFP project time.


1. Ward rotations

About Intern Education and Exam Preparation

There are weekly tutorials conducted by three preceptors which cover clinical pharmacy, OTC skills, legislation and APC topics are covered. Tutorials will also be provided by pharmacists working in specialty areas.

Mock oral exams are formally conducted in preparation for the pharmacy board oral exam. Designated study day is allocated for the pharmacy legislation preparation and intern written exam.

This is a great opportunity to develop your own skills by learning from different pharmacists in a supportive network.

The WH internship provides exposures to a diverse range of health services and opportunities to work with other health professionals (nurses, doctors, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, social workers, podiatrists, diabetes educators, and more).
