

Routine Antenatal Visits for Shared Antenatal Care at Sunshine Hospital

This summary reflects a minimum visit schedule. Additional visits should be arranged as appropriate.

Please note: Combined first trimester screening is not available via the hospital and needs to be ordered in the community by the GP.

6	34 weeks	SMCA <i>If antiD is required woman access this via Pregnancy Day Stay Unit</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Antenatal check
7	36 weeks	Sunshine Hospital	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Antenatal check • GBS swab • For women with a history of caesarean section: discussion with doctor re VBAC or elective caesarean.

9	39 weeks	SMCA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Antenatal check
10	40 weeks	SMCA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Antenatal check
