REFERRAL GUIDELINES LUNG CANCER SERVICE

Patients presenting with the following RED FLAGS require **<u>immediate</u>** referral to the Emergency Department:

- Moderate or severe haemoptysis
- Stridor
- Respiratory distress
- Symptoms of superior vena cava obstruction.

All other patients should be referred to Outpatients. Patients being referred for suspected cancer are considered urgent referrals. See more information about cancer referral processes **here**.
