



A Haematology Clinic is available at Western Health. The clinic is an MBS bulk bill clinic and operates from Sunbury Day Hospital weekly on a Friday morning.

Patients may choose to use their private insurance or DVA cover in the event of a medical day procedure under the Sunbury Day Hospital Haematology Service.

Suitable for patients with any of the following clinical problems: • Lymphadenopathy • Abnormalities of FBE (reduced or elevated blood call levels) • Paraprotein • Elevated ferritin • Thrombosis (DVT/PE) • Any other clinical problems needing specialist Haematology assessment NB: this clinic is an MBS (Bulk Bill) clinic so patient must be eligible for Medicare	Dr Duncan Carradice	 Use of the VSRF is strongly encouraged Ensure patient details are current and correct Address referral to Dr Duncan Carradice at the Haematology Clinic (Sunbury) Provide your provider number and the patient's Medicare number Please include reasons for referral, current medications and investigation results Fax referrals to 8345 6856
